



73,000 triggers in 14 days!

CAMPAIGN FOR PERMANENT FLASHING SPEED SIGNS (FSS) IN HURSLEY VILLAGE

We are sure that many Hursley residents will have concerns over the amount of traffic travelling through our village above the 30mph limit. The recent temporary flashing speed limit sign placed at the north end of the village recorded 39,000 triggers in a ten day period, and the deployment at the south end of the village recorded 34,000 triggers in a fourteen day period. The signs were temporary, however, we are now looking to form a group to help campaign and fund-raise for the purchase of permanent FSS at both ends of the village. These will be used to raise the awareness of speed issues and to remind drivers to stick to the 30mph speed limit.

Research has shown that flashing speed signs have proved their worth by cutting vehicle speeds significantly wherever they have been deployed. In the first instance we need to recruit people who are prepared to help support and fund raise for the cause in general. Once we have a support group, Councillor Eleanor Bell has committed to taking up our cause with the relevant council department.

Speeding is antisocial. You have the chance to make the village safer. Let's not let all the hard work that "*Hursley 30 Now!*" put in go to waste, by having the speed limit ignored by a high percentage of drivers travelling through our village. Statistics show that if you hit a child at 35mph you will cause serious injury, at 40 mph a fatality will most likely occur. Speeding also causes noise and pollution, which can seriously affect the quality of life in our village.
